ORDER

1. The learned counsel mentioned the matter that the shorter date be given to hear the Interlocutory Application. He also made the grievance that the applicant failed to file reply to the Interlocutory Application. The applicant seeks declaratory relief that the mortgage/collateral security be cancelled and is non-est, invalid, void and seeks the direction against the applicant to release the Panvel property, that is, Commercial Property land with structure bearing survey no.102/A, 103/1/2/A and 103/2AA situated at village Khanavale, Taluka Panvel. Area of 5460 sq. meters and to handover

all the title deeds as stated therein. The prayer clause indicates that the applicant seeks declaratory relief against the bank at the interim stage. At this stage, Mr Ranjan submits that he does not press in the Interlocutory Application and makes the endorsement with liberty to file fresh. Since the learned counsel does not press for the relief in terms of I.A. the question of passing order in I.A. does not arise. Hence, I.A. stands disposed of with liberty to file fresh I.A. as per law.
